Important Safety Instructions



WARNING: Do not use this appliance near water contained in bathtubs, basins or other vessels. This appliance is not intended for use by young children or infirm persons without supervision. Young children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

When the hair dryer is used in a bathroom, unplug the appliance after use since the proximity of water presents a hazard, even when the hair dryer is switched off.

WARNING: This appliance must not be taken into the bathroom. For additional protection, the installation of a residual current device (RCD) with a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30mA is advisable in the electrical circuit. Ask your installer for advice.

Keep this appliance away from water. Plug your hair dryer into an alternating current (~) outlet only. Be sure that the household voltage corresponds to voltage marked on the hair dryer. Neither should the appliance be used with wet hands nor immersed in water, held in running water, or allowed to become wet (e.g., as in splashing). Always unplug the appliance when not in use. Do not place the heated appliance on any heat-sensitive surface when hot or when plugged in. When using the appliance, care must be taken to prevent hair ingress into the air inlet openings.

Note: Use on towel dried hair only.

Overheating Cutoff

This appliance is equipped with a thermostat that will cycle OFF if the temperature exceeds the comfort level due to partially blocked air inlet or outlet openings. In the event that the appliance only produces cool air, turn the appliance OFF and allow it to cool down. Once the appliance cools, the thermostat will automatically reset and usage may resume. During use, do not block the air openings. Periodic cleaning of the rear intake cap is required to maintain proper performance. While using this hair dryer, it will get hot at the air outlet. Avoid touching the air outlet or any accessories attached to the outlet.

Storage

When not in use “unplug it.”

Never touch the pins of the plug as some electricity may still exist in the product’s circuit, even if it is unplugged.

Allow the appliance to cool and store in a dry location. Never wrap the cable around the appliance, since this will cause the cable to wear prematurely and break. If the power supply cable of this appliance becomes damaged, it must be replaced by returning to the retailer from which the product was purchased or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard. Regularly check the main cable for wear and damage, particularly where it enters the appliance and the plug.

Do not direct the airflow towards the eyes or other sensitive areas.

Do not use the hair dryer for purposes other than drying and styling human hair.

INSTRUCTION FOR USE

- Insert the plug in the wall socket.
- Switch the appliance on by selection the desired setting.
- The airflow and temperature can be adjusted:

Speed and Heat setting

- High speed & High heat
- Low speed & Medium heat
- OFF

Once the desired style is achieved, push the Cool Shot button to set the style with a flow of cool air. Do not blow at one place for long time, and blow your hair with continuous moving to avoid damage to hair.

CARE AND CLEANING

- Switch off the hair dryer and unplug from the power supply.
- Wipe over the housing using a soft damp cloth.
- Remove and wash the concentrator in warm soapy water.
- Do not use hard abrasives or cleaners.
- Ensure that all parts are dried thoroughly with a soft dry towel.
